Purpose:

To conserve agricultural electrical use by replacing the use of conventional stock tanks and electrical heaters with insulated, enclosed, freeze-resistant cattle fountains.

Availability:

Incentives are available to OTEC consumers within OTEC's service territory who install approved stock fountains that replace the use of conventional open stock tanks with stock tank heaters. The program begins October 1, 2006 and is expected to continue through September 30, 2009 depending on funding availability. OTEC may, however, modify or terminate this program without notice.

Product and installation specifications:

- Enclosed, fully foam-insulated cattle fountain
- Elliptical or flap closures that tip easily so animals can drink without resistance
- Closure must be insulated by foam insulation or dead air space and seal the opening completely
- Fountain water supply must be hard-piped underground and stubbed up into the insulated portion of the fountain
- Water supply must be electrically pumped by way of OTEC's electric distribution system
- Fountain cannot contain any type of electric heat
- Foam insulation must be completely sealed in impact-resistance polyurethane
- Minimum five-year manufacturer defect warranty

Incentives:

Payment will be made to OTEC consumers who install qualifying freeze-resistant cattle fountains. Payment amount will be \$165 per fountain unit after OTEC receives an original receipt, consumer-completed rebate form, and an OTEC visual inspection has been completed.
